The Purpose of Our Funds

The Fairy Godmethers' Funds (FGF) are Field of Interest Funds that are component funds of the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation (GMCF). There are three funds – the Endowed Fund, the Grants Fund, and the Operating Fund. The funds provide flexible monies to improve the health and well being of women with limited resources who have immediate needs not met by traditional funding resources within the community. In 2018 the Fairiy Godmothers added the Hand Up Grant (HUG) to provide financial assistance for a course or certification program that will lead to employment or job advancement for qualified women. www.fgfund.org

The Guardians established three Funds within the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation. One for operations, one for grants and one to establish an endowment. The earnings from the endowed fund, donations from fundraising events, and gifts directed to the Grants Fund provide flexible, accessible monies to address the short term and critical needs of men not being met by traditional funding sources. **www.gafund.erg**

Manhattan & Riley County men & women 18 year; & older are eligible to apply for grants. Funds are paid directly to providers of requested services & needs. Recipients are eligible for assistance once per 12-month period & the average grant is approximately \$750. Recipients are not asked to repay the grant, but to help someone else in the future through a pay-it-forward principle.

Fairy Godmother; & Guardian Grant;

the stories...

A single mom with three young sons recently got a job at Via Christi Hospital and needed car repairs to be able to get to and from work reliably. A grant of \$631.50 from the Fairy Godmothers provided new tires and alignment for it to be safe to drive.

A single disabled young man currently connot work. He had previously lived in transitional housing through Pawnee Mental Health Services and recently moved to an apartment complex. His disability income is not enough to afford a bed. He received a grant from the Guardians \$489.17 for a new bed so he can comfortably rest his head at night.

A longtime Manhattan resident who supports two children needed car repairs to her van. She has a wheelchair bound son and 16 year old granddaughter to support. The repairs totaled \$1,120 and the Fairy Godmothers provided \$800 to help pay the balance.

A local Manhattan man has had long term dental pain. He has an income of less than \$1000 per month and expenses of about \$650 per month. This does not leave room for extra dental expenses. He received a treatment plan from Konza Dental and was granted \$700 from the Guardians for dental work.

With support from the Fairy Godmothers, HUG grant recipient Shelby Lolley graduated in June from MATC with an LPN degree. She got a job working at Katie's Way as an LPN.

Thanks to Burnett Automotive and the discounts they provide, the Fairy Godmothers and Guardians are able to stretch the available grant money. Having a reliable vehicle is essential and much appreciation goes to Burnett for making sure these people are taken care of.
