The Purpose of Our Funds

The Fairy Godmothers' Funds were created in 2006 to provide an avenue for grants to local women in the Manhattan, KS, area with immediate needs that are not being met by traditional funding sources. In 2018, the Fairy Godmothers added the Hand Up Grant (HUG) to provide financial assistance for a course or certification program that will lead to employment or job advancement for qualified women. www.fgfund.org

The Guardians were established in 2013 in response to the growing success of the Fairy Godmothers. The Guardians help men with limited resources and immediate financial needs within the greater Manhattan, KS, area by providing access to funds for essential services not met by traditional funding sources. The Guardians aim to help men live self-sufficiently, with hope, and dignity, www.gafund.org

Manhattan & Riley County men & women 18 years & older are eligible to apply. Funds are paid directly to providers of requested services. Recipients are eligible for assistance once per 12-month period. The average grant is approximately \$750. Recipients are not asked to repay the grant, but to help someone else in the future through a pay-it-forward principle.

Grant Success Stories

This woman helps take care of her mom who has Parkinson's. Her father recently passed away. She works for Door Dash because it allows her flexibility with her mom's schedule. She has to have her car to work and there is no extra money to cover the extensive repairs. Her 19-year-old son just started working and is going to be able to help cover the cost of the rest of the bill. The request is for \$800 for a car repair with Burnett Automotive.

This disabled veteran was medically discharged 28 days before he would have received full retirement. He receives financial assistance from food stamps. The Guardians provided a grant to pay for his car repairs to ensure him and his wife can get to and from appointments.

Through the HUG Grant Program, the Fairies awarded a young woman a scholarship to complete a welding certificate. She will be a rising star in her field, following in her grandfather's footsteps and keeping the trade alive in the family. A HUG grant was also awarded to a Manhattan Christian College Student, now 50 years old, who plans on working in crisis intervention within our community. Lastly, the Fairies assisted with training two cosmetologists and launched a social worker on her way.

A local Manhattan man is currently caring for his two children after the passing of his wife. He is not currently working because he cares for the children and is taking care of loose ends. The Guardians provided a grant for auto repairs to keep up with his new responsibilities.
